Having Trouble Receiving Our Email News Blasts?

For those with AT&T or BellSouth e-mail addresses, e-mail from First Presbyterian is sometimes being routed to the spam folder. AT&T purchased BellSouth a few years back and then merged with Yahoo! for their e-mail.

Here’s how to check:

For those who use web-based e-mail: Simply click on your ‘Spam’ folder from time to time. Select the e-mails you want to allow through and click the “not spam” button at the top.

If you use Outlook/Outlook Express:

You will have to login to your AT&T/BellSouth web-based e-mail. Easiest, simplest, way to do it is go to <http://mail.yahoo.com> and login with your full e-mail address and password. Click on the ‘Spam’ folder and follow the instructions above.
