
Thank you for being a vital part of our church family. Your faithfulness and generosity are a testament to God's work in the world. Let's keep shining God's light, one act of kindness at a time.

# **New Sanctuary Fund**

#### **Sanctuary construction update:**

The Chapel has been repowered from an alternative source and the plywood protecting the glass entrance will be removed after demolition. When demolition of the old Sanctuary, Bell Tower and ET Smith lounge is complete, we will have a groundbreaking ceremony for the new Sanctuary. Additionally, a new sidewalk will then be placed along Royal Palm Boulevard to keep the same street crossing from the North Parking lot. (If the side entrance to the CCL is not yet open when you arrive, please use the Preschool Playground gates next to the building to cross over to the main entrance.)

The best timeline for the building process is 14 months to the Certificate of Occupancy, which will end Proctor Construction's involvement in the project. This timeline does not consider tropical weather in 2026; which during last month delayed our asbestos remediation by several weeks this year. At the point of gaining a C.O., we will have several other subcontractors working directly for FPCVB in order to stretch our generous contributions without having to pay a General Contractor management fee. These vendor partners will include Landscaping, IRWIN seating, Lutron mechanized shades, Murphy Lighting and Pearson Audio / Visual.




#### **Senior Saints: Growing Older In God's Family**
